ABSTRACT

Childbirth is a very special period for a woman and her family. It is usually joyful when a pregnant mother gives birth to a baby she has expected. Despite the pain and discomfort, birth is a long awaited grand ending of a pregnancy and a start of a new life. A mother is the beginning of a new chapter of human life. The process of labour not only generates new life but also it creates new species in the world thereby makes the world as an ever-ending place for the human beings to live. That's why mothers are special and labour is precious.

Now a day we are in a phase where we see large numbers of primi woman are gone through various aid which may be a surgical/ medical or both procedures that gives the horrible, terrifying and emotionally painful experience to the women.

The Bradley philosophy teaches that birth is a normal, natural, and healthy process and that woman should be empowered to approach it with confidence. Bradley birthing classes educate women about the ways they can decrease their perception of pain, such as through relaxation techniques, breathing exercises, distraction, or massage by a supportive coach. Its approach takes a neutral position toward pain medication, encouraging women to make an informed decision about whether it's right for them.

“EFFECT OF MODIFIED TRENDELENBURG POSITION ON HEMODIALYSIS PATIENTS: SYMPTOM IMPROVEMENT AND BLOOD PRESSURE DYNAMICS”

ABSTRACT

Introduction: Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) is a global health concern affecting approximately 10% of the world's population, with increasing prevalence attributed to aging, diabetes, and hypertension. Hemodialysis, a critical intervention in advanced CKD, is hampered by complications, notably hemodialysis-induced hypotension. This study explores the efficacy of the Modified Trendelenburg Position, an innovative body positioning technique, in mitigating hemodialysis-induced hypotension and improving overall hemodynamics. **Method:** Conducted as a prospective, randomized controlled trial, the research involved CKD patients undergoing routine hemodialysis. Participants meeting inclusion criteria, including CKD diagnosis, stable vital signs, and tolerance for the Modified Trendelenburg Position, were randomly assigned to the experimental or control group. The experimental group underwent hemodialysis with the modified position, while the control group received standard hemodialysis. Rigorous ethical guidelines, including Institutional Review Board approval and informed consent, were adhered to throughout the study. **Result:** The study encompassed a total of 60 participants, with a detailed analysis of demographic variables, including age, gender, and medical history. Significant improvements were observed in the experimental group, with a notable decrease in signs and symptoms of hypotension ($p=0.000$). Blood pressure dynamics, measured at different time points during hemodialysis, demonstrated positive mean changes in systolic and diastolic blood pressure in the experimental group, contrasting with negative changes in the control group. Fisher's Exact Test revealed no significant association between hypotension and demographic variables. **Conclusion:** The findings suggest that the Modified Trendelenburg Position has a substantial impact on alleviating hemodialysis-induced hypotension and improving blood pressure stability in CKD patients. Comparison with existing literature underscores the consistency of these results with previous studies.

Effectiveness of Rational Emotive Behavior Therapy on Level of Stress and Anxiety Among Sober Alcohol Dependents Attending Self Help Groups in Selected Areas

ABSTRACT

Introduction: Stress and anxiety are common, especially in challenging situations. Rational Emotive Behavior Therapy (REBT) helps manage these by addressing irrational thoughts. It is also effective in reducing emotional distress linked to alcohol addiction.

Methodology: This study evaluates the levels of stress and anxiety among sober alcohol dependents attending self-help groups and assesses the effectiveness of Rational Emotive Behavior Therapy (REBT) in reducing these levels. A quantitative, quasi-experimental non-randomized control group design was used, with 60 participants (30 in the control group and 30 in the experimental group) selected through convenience sampling. Conducted over 28 days, the research setting included selected self-help groups. Reliability scores for the stress and anxiety assessment tools were high (0.99) based on the test-retest method, ensuring the study's credibility. A pilot study confirmed feasibility for larger-scale research. The findings provide key insights into REBT's role in improving mental health among sober alcohol dependents.

Result: The study demonstrated that Rational Emotive Behavior Therapy (REBT) is significantly effective in reducing both stress and anxiety among sober alcohol dependents attending self-help groups. For stress, pretest results in the experimental group showed 43.3% of participants had moderate stress and 56.7% had high stress. Posttest results revealed substantial improvement, with 33.3% reporting low stress and 66.7% reporting moderate stress. The paired t-test showed a significant reduction in stress scores, with an average decrease from 26.8 to 16.6 (p -value < 0.05). Similarly, anxiety levels improved significantly. In the experimental group, pretest anxiety results showed 56.7% with moderate anxiety, which dropped to 13.3% posttest. The paired t-test revealed a significant decrease in anxiety scores from 26 to 15.3 (p -value < 0.05). Comparison between experimental and control groups also confirmed the significant impact of REBT on reducing both stress and anxiety levels.

Conclusion: The findings suggest that REBT is a highly effective intervention for managing stress and anxiety in sober alcohol dependents.

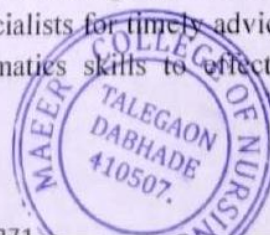

ABSTRACT

Management of chronic diseases such as diabetes mellitus (DM) is difficult. People living with chronic diseases face challenges related to knowledge deficiencies, inability to sustain lifestyle modifications, and scarce access to specialists for timely advice. Although rates of SH in children and adolescents have decreased significantly in the past two decades, due to improvements in insulin administration and monitoring technologies. The review aims to summarize and critically appraise the evidence regarding the association between hypoglycemia and QoL (and related outcomes) in children and adolescents with type 1 diabetes. The PubMed, CINAHL and EBSCO database were searched for studies. The articles were searched by following inclusion and exclusion criteria. The articles published in English are considered. The journals which are peer reviewed are considered and included to manage the trustworthiness of the evidence. The articles published in the last 10 Years were considered. Out of 270 articles total 8 articles finalised. The findings showed that No hypoglycemia-specific measures of QoL were identified. Evidence for an association between SH and (domains) of generic and diabetes-specific QoL was too limited to draw conclusions, due to heterogenous definitions and operationalizations of hypoglycemia and outcomes across studies. SH was associated with greater worry about hypoglycemia, but was not clearly associated with diabetes distress, depression, anxiety, disordered eating or posttraumatic stress disorder. Although limited, some evidence suggests that more recent, more frequent, or more severe episodes of hypoglycemia may be associated with adverse outcomes and that the context in which hypoglycemia takes places might be important in relation to its impact.

ABSTRACT

Introduction: This study investigates the effectiveness of gratitude therapy in reducing perceived stress and enhancing self-efficacy among teenagers, addressing the critical need for targeted interventions in the realm of teenagers mental health. **Methods:** Utilizing a quasi-experimental design with pre-test and post-test assessments, 80 participants were divided into experimental and control groups. Gratitude therapy sessions were administered to the experimental group, incorporating structured exercises to cultivate gratitude. **Result:** The sociodemographic analysis revealed a predominant age group of 16-17 years, with a gender distribution of 61.25% males and 38.75% females. Birth order emerged as a significant predictor of self-efficacy, emphasizing the need for personalized interventions. Associations were found between pretest stress scores and family structures, indicating higher stress levels in nuclear families. Gratitude therapy resulted in a substantial reduction in perceived stress among the experimental group, transitioning from severe to mild stress levels. In contrast, the control group exhibited minimal changes. **Conclusion:** The study contributes valuable insights for educators, mental health professionals, and policymakers, suggesting the integration of gratitude therapy in school-based programs for teenagers well-being. The robustness of the findings highlights the potential of gratitude-focused interventions to foster resilience and positive mental health outcomes in the complex landscape of teenagers development.

INTRODUCTION

In contemporary society, the well-being of teenagers has become a subject of paramount importance, considering the myriad challenges and stressors they encounter during this critical phase of development.(1) This study delves into the realm of psychological interventions, focusing specifically on the effectiveness of gratitude therapy in mitigating perceived stress and enhancing self-efficacy among teenagers.(2) Acknowledging the intricate interplay between sociodemographic factors and mental health, the research aims to provide insights into the dynamics of stress and self-efficacy concerning age, gender, family type, and birth order.(3)

Intravenous therapy serves the crucial purpose of administering medications regularly to patients, a widely practiced procedure in hospitals worldwide, despite its commonality, intravenous cannulation, have lot of potential complications, which can be categorized as either local or systemic.(1) Local complications encompass issues such as Phlebitis, Infiltration, Extravasation, Hemorrhage, and Local Infections. On the other hand, systemic complications include Pulmonary Edema, Air Embolism, Catheter Embolism, and Catheter-related Bloodstream Infections.(2)

Among these complications, Phlebitis stands out as the most prevalent, with incidence rates varying across different healthcare settings, ranging from 3.7% to 67.24%.(3) Paediatric thrombophlebitis, specifically second-grade superficial thrombophlebitis, is a condition that demands careful consideration due to its prevalence among children admitted to Paediatric units.(4) The management of such cases poses a unique challenge, requiring effective and evidence-based practices to ensure optimal patient outcomes. Superficial thrombophlebitis in Paediatric patients has gained attention as a critical concern, necessitating tailored interventions for effective resolution. (5)

The choice between Thrombophob ointment and Magnesium Sulphate Dressing as primary treatment modalities reflects the need for a comprehensive evaluation of their efficacy in managing second-grade superficial thrombophlebitis.(6)

Existing literature underscores the importance of evidence-based practices in Paediatric care, and our study contributes by directly comparing these two treatments. Moreover, the exploration of demographic variables such as age, gender, and duration of intravenous cannula insertion allows for a nuanced understanding of potential influencing factors on treatment effectiveness and patient experiences. As we embark on this investigation, we anticipate that our findings will not only inform clinical practices but also stimulate further research aimed at refining and advancing the care provided to children with thrombophlebitis in Paediatric settings. Ultimately, this study serves as a valuable step towards enhancing the quality of care for Paediatric patients facing this specific medical challenge. This study aims to delve into the varied practices employed in the treatment of second-grade superficial thrombophlebitis among children in selected Paediatric hospitals. Through a meticulous survey, we explore the prevailing approaches, with a particular focus on the comparison between two commonly used practices—Thrombophob ointment and Magnesium Sulphate Dressing. Additionally, we investigate potential associations between these practices and selected demographic variables, contributing valuable insights to the existing body of knowledge.

METHODOLOGY

Study Design: A survey and factorial research design was adopted to achieve the objectives of this study. The research involved the collection and analysis of data related to the practices used in treating second-grade superficial thrombophlebitis among children in selected Paediatric units.

Population: The study comprised 30 children (15 in each group) admitted to the Paediatric units of the selected hospitals, all diagnosed with second-grade superficial thrombophlebitis. The inclusion criteria covered a broad age range from 1 month to 15 years, with variations in the duration of intravenous cannula insertion.



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
